1. Develop a classroom jargon that identifies your classroom.

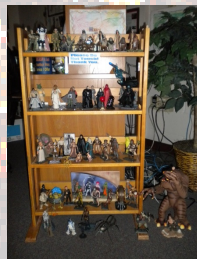
Take Aways
